Chairman's Trophy	96	<b>Champagne Marion-Bosser Premier Cru Extra Brut Blanc de Blancs Champagne (France), \$51.99</b>  The pinpoint mousse is delightfully prickly, clean, and refreshingly acidic. First nosings discover multiple layers of baker's yeast, sourdough, buttered toast, and lemon peel. In the mouth, the flavor profile explodes with stone dry, seed-like tastes of ripe grapes, citrus, sesame seed. The silky texture elegantly wraps the entire sensory experience with substance and class. Top-notch luxury. <b>Great Value. Extraordinary, Ultimate Recommendation</b>
Finalist	93	<b>Moet &amp; Chandon Imperial Brut Rose Epernay (France), \$55.00</b>  Visual effect of the mesmerizing pale rose color is memorable. First inhalations feature subtle fragrances of ripe peach, nectarine, pink grapefruit, black grapes, raisins. Taste profile highlights the orchard fruit freshness and tanginess that's both acidic and moderately tannic, but dazzlingly concentrated on grapiness. Finishes long and languid. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>

<p>Pleasant toasty aromas of just baked brioche mix with undertones of honeyed almond and white flowers. The mousse is creamy on the palate, with bright lemony flavors augmented by crisp minerality and a chalky finish. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b></p>		
Finalist	92	<b>Moët &amp; Chandon Imperial Brut Epernay (France), \$41.00</b>
<p>Pale straw tone. Mineral, limestone aromas on the nose. Apple tastes on the palate, an appealing hint of crisp pear character also come across. Bubbles are fine while a stony minerality is apparent. An excellent bubbly for all occasions. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b></p>

<p>This sparkling wine carries a deep pink hue. The palate is driven by citrus, taking the form of tangerines, orange, and there is a hint of Californian persimmons. Dry, but with a delightfully fruity character. An easy quaffer. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b></p>		
Finalist	93	<b>Marques de la Concordia Millesime Reserva de la Familia Rose Brut Cava (Spain), \$13.99</b>
<p>A lovely, light pink hue. Pit fruit aromas float from the glass. Bubbles charge onto the palate with a taste of peach and nectarine. Though the fruit here is intense, it is all enveloped in a mineral dryness that balances this wine completely. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b></p>		
Finalist	93	<b>Marques de la Concordia Seleccion Especial Brut 2012 Cava (Spain), \$11.99</b>
<p>Straw hue with flecks of gold. Seville orange marmalade come through in the perfume. Citrus drives the palate in the form of orange, meyer lemon and clementines. Long, lingering acidity and a slightly richer palate than is usual for a Brut. A crowd pleasing sparkling wine. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b></p>		

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91 **Marques de la Concordia Millesime Reserva de Familia  
Brut 2009 Cava (Spain), \$13.99**

Bright, titillating bubbles with a nose that is reminiscent of smoke, along with dried Turkish apricots. Spice wafts from the glass, while the palate offers more dried fruits and cinnamon spice. Great for those that like a fruit-driven, yet dry, bubbly.

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88 **Marques de la Concordia Seleccion Especial Rose Brut  
2012 Cava (Spain), \$11.99**

This cava pours a pretty blush color with a creamy and persistent mousse. As the bubbles dissipate, fresh fruity and floral aromas emerge from the glass. The fruit carries on through to the palate. Dry and clean, yet lively and effervescent.

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A pale yellow-straw color in the glass, this prosecco bursts with aromas of peaches and nectarines, as well as white flowers. In the mouth, it's crisp and refreshing, but with a creamy texture thanks to a persistent mousse and a clean finish.

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Finalist	93	<b>Zonin Prosecco Veneto (Italy), \$14.99</b>
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Pale straw-colored, this softly effervescent prosecco is bursting with fresh aromas of summer fruits and flowers. Easy-drinking at a pleasant 11% ABV, it's crisp and refreshing on the palate, with a hint of minerality and a nice, clean finish.

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This pale straw-colored prosecco pours with a fine, persistent fizz. As the bubbles dissipate, subtly peachy and floral aromas emerge from the glass. In the mouth, it's crisp and refreshing with a clean finish. Lovely as an aperitif.

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91 **Astoria Prosecco Treviso (Italy), \$13.99**

This pale yellow prosecco pours with a fine, persistent mousse. Bursting with fruity aromas of peaches and berry bubblegum, it's lively and refreshing citrus in the mouth. At just 11%, it's an easy-drinking aperitif: dry with a hint sweetness. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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91 **Corte Giona Extra Dry Prosecco (Italy), \$15.99**

A delicate straw yellow in the glass with persistent bubbles. Plentiful citrus and orchard fruit aromas rise from the glass and on the palate it is dry, fruity, and mineral. A zippy acidity leads into the finish which is fruit-forward and exquisitely dry. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Menage a Trois Prosecco Veneto (Italy), \$14.00**

This lively, fruity prosecco pours with a fine, persistent fizz. As the effervescence settles down, notes of tart apple and citrus emerge with hints of candied fruit. Nose tickling and tongue prickling, it's a perky bubbly with a clean finish. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Zardetto Brut Treviso Prosecco (Italy), \$16.00**

Pretty appearance that's a blizzard of small pinpoint bubbles. Nose is alive with garden fresh aromas of grapefruit, apricot, quince, white grapes. Entry and midpalate are zesty, piquant, spicy, citrusy, grapy, almost tonic-like. Finishes long, prickly, loaded with vivid grapy charm. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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89 **Cupcake Prosecco Italy (Italy), \$14.00**

Pale yellow in the glass with fine, persistent bubbles, this prosecco is full of fresh, peachy and floral aromas. In the mouth it's creamy yet bright, bursting with lemon-lime flavors and leaving you with just a hint of sweetness on the finish. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

Opens with bright pear and green apple notes with a touch of honey and white flower. On the palate it is dry with orchard fruits accompanied by a brisk acidity and a fine mousse. The finish is dry with Granny Smith apple. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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Finalist 92 **Chateau Frank Brut 2008 Finger Lakes (United States), \$24.99**

This dry sparkler opens up with aromas of rising bread dough, giving way to fresh fruity notes of notes of citrus and stone fruit. It shows plenty of wet-slate minerality and a hint of the saline. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Barefoot Bubbly Red Moscato California (United States), \$9.90**

Fresh and lively nose of candied rose petal, clementine, strawberry jam, and red raspberries. On the palate it is sweet and fruit-forward with ripe strawberry, raspberry jam, and acai berry. The finish is sweet, fruity, and pleasant. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Gloria Ferrer Blanc de Noirs Sonoma County (United States), \$22.00**

Incredibly fresh aromas of citrus and light toast are crisp and refreshing. In the mouth it is piquant with plenty of bright stone fruit flavors integrated with a nice toasted wood on the lip-smacking finish. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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89 **Chronic Cellars Spritz & Giggles California (United States), \$17.99**

Clean aromas of pears and minerals are light and opulent. Small tight bubbles give way to a creamy mouthfeel that highlights apple and pear flavors mixed with rounded floral notes that continue to linger on the palate. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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87 **Barefoot Bubbly Pink Moscato California (United States), \$9.99**

White peaches and meyer lemon offer a balanced aroma. Tart and lightly sweet, it is fruity on the palate with hints of lemon candy and white flowers. The texture is light with a soft bubble. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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87 **Pink Zebra Pink Sparkling 2013 California (United States), \$10.99**

Finalist	93	<b>Frei Brothers Reserve Chardonnay 2013 Russian River Valley (United States), \$20.00</b>
		This wine shows a pale straw stain. Delivers a dazzling nose of bright, fresh apples. The wine has sturdy backbone, balanced out by pretty, soft fruit flavors. The acidity is mellow yet present. Overall, a lovely easy-drinking wine. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>

		The nose is delightfully restrained with chalky minerals, lime zest, sweet nectarine, and pear. On the palate it is fresh with pear, citrus, zesty barrel spice, and pineapple. Pineapple returns on the finish with minerals and lime. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>
Finalist	92	<b>Rodney Strong Chardonnay 2013 Sonoma County (United States), \$17.00</b>
		Peaches and cream leap from the glass followed by more delicate hints of apples, blossom, and toasted oak. Oak is present on the palate with orange marmalade, apples, minerals and the finish is lengthy, warm, and citrus fruit runs rampant. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>
	91	<b>Cambridge &amp; Sunset California Series Chardonnay 2013 California (United States), \$13.99</b>
		Juicy ripe fruit character plays out in this wine. There is a sense of poached pears on the palate, with a delicate hint of baked apple. Menthol hints weave in and out as the wine opens up in the glass. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>
	91	<b>Chateau Ste. Michelle Canoe Ridge Estate Chardonnay 2013 Horse Heaven Hills (United States), \$20.00</b>
		Toasted oak, fresh cream, almond, and dried apricot come to mind on the nose. The palate is rich and nutty with am toast spice and notes of apples and citrus. The finish is quite elegant. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>
	91	<b>Chloe Chardonnay 2012 Sonoma County (United States), \$14.00</b>
		Oak and ripe apples penetrate the nose. Possesses a rounded, rich palate with fruit that consists of classic oaked-chardonnay flavors such as butter and vanilla bean. Fat and luscious textured, this is a wine to appeal to the Californian chardonnay fan. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>

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91 **Gnarly Head Chardonnay 2013 California (United States),  
\$9.99**

Clear with a hint of delicate straw color. Nose shows candied fruit and ripe berries such as blackberries and raspberries. The palate verges on sweet and is intense with ripe fruit flavors. Luscious, juicy and honeyed. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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91 **Mirassou Chardonnay 2012 Central Coast (United States),  
\$12.00**

Herbal aromas and ripe peach and apricot pit fruits, with a hint of oak and toast. Sun baked earth comes through, giving a taste of Californian terroir. Citrus orange acidity plays into the medley of fruit in this fun drinking wine. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Bota Box Chardonnay 2013 California (United States),  
\$22.99, 3L Box**

Ripe pears burst on the nose of this lively quencher. Citrus fruits join the Rosaceae family of fruits to make this a zinger of a wine. Mouth-watering and easy to drink with the kind of acidity that sings for food. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Estancia Chardonnay 2013 Monterey County (United States), \$11.00**

Rich with fruits, this wine is like the king of chardonnays. The finish lingers for a long time with aromas and tastes of ripe tropical bananas. If you like tutti-frutti flavors, this wine is for you. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **HandCraft Chardonnay 2013 California (United States),  
\$11.99**

Oaky and menthol nose with a gorgeous floral fragrance. There is a hint of sweetness here, with zingy acidity and a mouthful of citrus and ripe nectarine. This lovely quaffer is an instantly likeable wine that sings of spring and summer flowers and fruits. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **La Merika Chardonnay 2013 Central Coast (United States), \$12.99**

Offers a tempting oaky nose delivered with a touch of spearmint. Delivers gorgeous bright acidity that is reminiscent of orange skins. White flowers and vanilla seeds permeate the palate. A bright and thoroughly and cheerful wine. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Light Horse Chardonnay 2013 California (United States), \$14.99**

This lush, round wine opens up with aromas of stone fruit and honey-buttered toast. On the palate, it shows green apple, citrus and a whiff of vanilla. The texture is luxuriously viscous without being heavy. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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90 **Noble Vines 446 San Bernabe Vineyard Chardonnay 2013 Monterey (United States), \$12.99**

A fresh breezy scent that makes way for peach aromas. Pit fruits show up on the palate, with light oak flavors and a delicious hint of seawater. Berry fruits creep up on the finish, think boysenberry and gooseberries. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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89 **Columbia Chardonnay 2013 Columbia Valley (United States), \$14.00**

Boasts a rich straw hue and a palate of juicy fruits. Enticing ocean sea breezes fill the aromas, accompanied by toasty oak. The palate is plush and mouth-filling, laced with invigorating citrus acidity. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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89 **Oak Leaf Chardonnay American (United States), \$2.99**

Oak, vanilla and musk burst forth from the glass. Tropical fruits such as pineapple and dragon fruit turn up on the palate, encased in singing acidity. This is a zingy wine that is grounded by oak flavors -- all nicely integrated. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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88 **Edna Valley Chardonnay 2013 Central Coast (United States), \$15.00**

A classy chardonnay that offers soft, delicate aromas and tastes. Beurre blanc comes with an enticing aroma and flavor of freshly cut grass. This is a wine that is both light on its feet and complex in character, all with just the right amount of acidity. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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88 **Robert Mondavi Private Selection Chardonnay 2013 Central Coast (United States), \$11.00**

Tropical melon, preserved lemons, almonds, and a toasty spice comprise the bouquet. The palate is rich and ripe with butter, mango, toast, and sweet spice that linger on a round, toasty finish. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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88 **U by Underraga Chardonnay-Riesling 2014 Valle Central (Chile), \$9.99**

Toasted oak aromas give way to cantaloupe melons on the palate. There is a thread of a sea-like note weaving its way through the palate, also giving this wine fresh, invigorating acidity. A highly aromatic wine. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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87 **Line 39 Chardonnay 2014 California (United States), \$10.00**

Shows a subtle straw hue, this is a moxie chardonnay with orange meringue flavors and frosted icing that sings. Herbal mint character accompanies the confectionary character, while oak permeates the palate, leaving a long, lingering finishing. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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86 **Cul-de-Sac Chardonnay American (United States), \$4.99**

A citrus fruit-driven wine that points to grapefruit and pomelo. There is a hint of baking spice, think cinnamon, joined by grapefruit pith. The mouthfeel is rich and textured, while the taste lingers on the palate. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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86 **Domino Chardonnay 2013 California (United States), \$7.49**

A deep toasty oaked nose, with a hint of eau-de-cologne. A bold and assertive wine that reveals buttery-rich character with the aforementioned oak on the palate. Lovely bright fruit enliven the big oak flavors, while the finish is filled with radiant oranges. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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85 **Barefoot Cellars Chardonnay California (United States), \$6.99**

This fresh and fruity chardonnay gives off summertime areas of peaches and honey. In the mouth, it's lush yet tart, with notes of green apple, butter and vanilla. Soft melon and yellow pear linger on the finish. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

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85 **Sutter Home Winery Chardonnay California (United States), \$6.00**

This fun and flirty chardonnay is brimming with peachy and floral aromas. In the mouth, it's silky yet lively, showing plenty of citrus, green apple, and vanilla character with a pretty whiff of peaches and cream on the finish. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**

Finalist	92	<b>Cross River Sauvignon Blanc 2014 Marlborough (New Zealand), \$15.99</b>  Typical varietal characteristics of tropical fruit and grassy notes come through on the nose of this sauvignon blanc. In the mouth, it shows plenty of tart gooseberry, guava and lemongrass. A crisp and zingy white. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>
Finalist	92	<b>Tiki Sound Sauvignon Blanc 2014 Marlborough (New Zealand), \$15.99</b>  This sauvignon blanc opens up with a typically grassy nose, but you can also detect a whiff of fresh wild flowers there. In the mouth, it's a lively party of tart green apples, citrus and gooseberry. Zingy and refreshing. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>

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Finalist	92	<b>Two Oceans Sauvignon Blanc 2015 Western Cape (South Africa), \$7.99</b>	On the nose it is spicy with grapefruit zest, apples, and jalapeño aromas. 	91	<b>14 Hands Sauvignon Blanc 2014 Washington (United States), \$10.00</b>	Classic nose of sweet grass, citrus, sea minerals, and green apple. 	91	<b>Casablanca Nimbus Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc 2014 Casablanca Valley (Chile), \$14.99</b>	A zingy and aromatic sauvignon blanc with invigorating green notes of fresh herbs on the nose. In the mouth, it's brimming with tart passion fruit, ripe melon, white peaches and a hint of spice on the finish. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>

Fresh and lively on the palate with a clean finish. <b>Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended</b>

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90 **The Crossings Sauvignon Blanc 2014 Marlborough (New Zealand), \$14.99**

An invigorating bouquet of lime zest and fresh herbs bursts forth from the glass. In the mouth, this sauvignon blanc is juicy and lively, with plenty of fresh lime juice, gooseberry and a hint of pepper on the finish. **Great Value. Excellent, Highly Recommended**

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88 **Barefoot Cellars Sauvignon Blanc California (United States), \$6.99**

Typical varietal notes of “green” come through on this sauvignon blanc: fresh herbs, lime juice. On the palate, it’s all tart passion fruit, ripe melon and white peaches. A lush yet lively wine full of fresh, zingy flavors. **Great Value. Very Good, Strong Recommendation**
